Rules and Entry Form**

**Contest Rules:**

- Only amateur bakers may enter; no professionals please.
- The **first 15** entries will be eligible for the contest.
- Completed entry form must be received by **September 14**.
- A copy of the recipe **MUST** accompany your entry; include your name, address, and phone number on the recipe.
- **Dessert must not** require refrigeration. **NO cream cheese** in your dessert, please.
- In-season apples must be a featured ingredient in the final product.
- Dessert must be made from scratch; no store-bought filling, crusts, toppings, etc.
- Container must be disposable (since we may not be able to return it).
- Winner agrees to have his/her photo and recipe published in the Northbrook Farmers Market *Fresh Connection* newsletter, Northbrook Historical Society Town Crier and local media outlets.

**Judging:**

- Desserts must be brought to the judges' table between noon and 12:30 p.m. The judges' table is located in the Village Green Center.
- Judging will begin promptly at 1 p.m.
- Winner will be announced when judges have reached a decision.
- Winner must be present to accept the prize and for a photo shoot.
- Decision of the judges is final.

**Criteria:**

- **Appearance:** 5 points
- **Texture (how it feels in the mouth):** 5 points
- **Overall flavor, taste, yumminess:** 5 points

**Prize:** The winner will receive a \$100 dining gift certificate from House 406.
