

Date and Time:

The Cow Pie Moo-lette Facebook Live event will begin at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday October 18, 2020. The wait for a Cow "Pie" will end when the cow's "business" is done, or the time allotted of 30 minutes has expired.

Entry Donation:

Each square will be sold for \$20.00. There will be up to 289 squares sold.

Prize:

Raffle prize money is determined by the sale of the tickets, if less than 100 tickets are sold, the prize money will be 50% of the ticket sales. After 100 tickets are sold, the prize of up to \$1,000 is determined by the cow and rule 8.

Cow Pie Moo-lette Rules:

1. Due to COVID-19, the event this year will be pre-recorded and will be virtual..
2. You must be at least 18 years of age to participate.
3. Each ticket represents one 3-foot square on the grid.
4. The Moo-lette grid will be laid out on the field at Wagner Farm with a maximum of 289 squares.
5. The square numbers will be assigned randomly by a computer PROGRAM at the start of the Facebook Live Event.
6. The complete pre-recorded video will be played with sections fast-forwarded until just before the Cow "**Pie**" is delivered.
7. All decisions of the referee are final.
8. The first Cow "**Pie**" dropped determines the winner.
 - If there is no Cow "**Pie**" dropped within 30 minutes the winner will be determined by the placement of the cow's right hoof. If that square is unsold, a ticket stub will be drawn to pick the winner
 - If the "**Pie**" drops in 2 squares, then 2 winners will divide the money, 3 squares – 3 winners, 4 squares – 4 winners. In case one or more squares were unsold when there is a Cow "**Pie**" dropped in multiple squares tickets stubs will be drawn to pick the winners of the unsold square(s). **Splatters do not count. Lines are neutral.**
9. The ticket stubs will be secured by event organizer until the event is completed.
10. The name of the winning ticket(s) holder(s) will be announced at the end of the event. Winners will also be called.

12. The event is sponsored by and benefits the Northbrook Historical Society. It is being conducted by the Northbrook Historical Society, a not-for-profit charitable organization. The Raffle is being conducted pursuant to the Illinois Raffles and Poker Runs Act, *230 ILCS 15/0.01 et seq.* to raise funds for ongoing charitable purposes. These Official Rules (the "**Official Rules**") govern the Raffle.
